packing checklist

*Be sure items are labeled with your name!

- Maranatha swag! Warmup jacket, t-shirt, etc
- Hair necessities (pulled back & professional for all classes)
- 2-3 leotards
- 2-3 pairs of tights

- Camera (phones should be in airplane mode or off during class)
- Food for breakfast, lunch, and snacks
- Costume pieces for Showcase, if performing
- Dance Bag with:
 - Jazz shoes
 - Ballet shoes
 - Hip Hop sneakers (jazz shoes can also be worn in Hip Hop class)
 - Socks
 - Refillable water bottle
 - Leggings, dance shorts, ballet skirt
 - Tank tops or t-shirts
 - Extra hair ties, bobby pins
- "It's Electric Dance Party" (Friday night)- Wear something that shines, lights up, or electrifies!
- Parents: Be sure to bring a sweater or jacket. The ballrooms are kept very cool for the comfort of the dancers.

All performers must be in the dressing room 5 numbers prior to their performance. All showcase performers must wear cover-ups while in the audience and outside the ballroom.

- You must purchase a Video Class Pass if you plan on recording any classes. DR will have a
 professional videographer for all other major events that will be made available to order. You will
 not be allowed to tape Friday night, during the Showcase, Production or Faculty Show.
- Wristbands must be worn at all times. Students may only dance in their designated ballroom.
 Observers will not be allowed into teacher classes. There is no charge for children as Observers under 6 years old.
- Students wanting to change levels must do so within the first three classes of the convention and with the permission of the student's studio director.
