Grades 3-12 (All interested participants)

In this pressure -free workshop, students will play games and have fun while exploring acting, vocalizing, and dance. Students do not need to be prepared with anything except to arrive in comfortable, movable clothing and closed-toed footwear such as sneakers or jazz shoes.

Students in 3^{rd} through 6^{th} grade are dismissed after the workshop. Students in 3^{rd} through 6^{th} grade may choose to participate in individual auditions if they would like a higher chance to be considered for a lead role or to practice their auditioning skills! However, participation does not ensure a lead role and they may still be cast in a lead/supporting role without participating in an individual audition. Individual auditions are not required for students in $3^{rd} - 6^{th}$ grade.

6:35 – 7:30pm Individual auditions

Grades 7th - 12th

Students should be prepared with a 1 minute comedic monologue and 16 bars of a musical theater song. Students may provide an accompaniment on their phone or sing a cappella (without music). They are welcome to bring any headshots/resumes they have (including their 'Finding Nemo' program headshot if they were a participant).

The primary goal of the actor during individual auditions are to be brave! Make strong acting choices! As such, if a student would feel more comfortable reciting a poem they learned in school or a section of the bible, that is acceptable as an audition "monologue." Would they prefer to sing a praise song? Totally fine! Again, whether singing or speaking, think about what the author/performer of the piece is saying and chose a strong acting choice to support the song or monologue.
